of Section 13 and the SW 1/4 of Section 13 and
the South E 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11 and the E 1/4
of the NE 1/4 of Section 14 all in Township 20 Range
one North E 1/4 together with all the appurtenances there-
unto belonging the conveyance is intended as a
mortgage to secure the payment two hundred &
fifty dollars due the 1st day of December 1839
on two notes given to All Lester now if the

above amount by the specified time then this
mortgage to be void but if he fail to do so the
