

This indenture made and entered into the 7th day of February A D 1837 between Eleanor B Barnett of Shelby County of the first part and Harriet A Ward of the same County and State of the second part Witnesses that for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which the said party of the first part hath for the said party of the second part and for the further consideration of five dollars to the said party of the first part he have paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said party of the first part hath given granted conveyed and sold and by these presents doth give grant convey and sell unto the said party of the second part the following described lot lying and being in the Town of Calverton in the West District at the S.W. Corner of the said lot in said Town and running about fifteen steps to a corner N of S.B. Rogers S.W. and on the N side of the Street from the corner of said Rogers lot thence East about sixty steps along the Street leading from the Court house to Mr Harkins thence to a corner thence N about thirty steps to a corner & close by the S.W. Corner of a house of Rogers to a corner thence West about ten steps along behind a stable on said lot to a corner thence S about ten

Steps to another Corner thence West along the S side
of the Calhoun to the beginning to have and to hold
all the interest of said party of the first part in
said lot so situated to said party of the second
part his heirs and assigns forever and the said
party of the first part binds himself his heirs and
assigns to warrant and defend the title of said
lot to the said party of the second part.
