

This indenture made and entered into this the 18th of
 January one thousand eight hundred and fifty
 nine by and between John Ware and his wife Elizabeth
 Mary Ware of the first part and Sarah E. Sillors
 (formerly Sarah E. Harold) Ephraim S. Harold Wilcox
 A. Harold John S. Harold Eli Harold George E. Harold
 James S. Harold Laura S. Harold of the second part
 Witnesseth That whereas the said party of the first
 part sold to Eli Harold so in his lifetime & execu-
 -ted a bond for letting them to the following descri-
 -bed tract or parcel of Land to wit the E 1/4
 of Sec 8 T 20 R 3 West also the E 1/4 of the N 1/4 of
 Sec 8 T 20 R 3 West also the N 1/4 of the S 1/2 of Sec
 9 T 20 R 3 West also E 1/4 of N 1/4 of Sec 9 T 20 R 3
 West with the exception of that portion of the
 last described piece lying on the N E side
 of the Coho-la river reserving the right of the
 Wide Channel of the river as being in that

portion of the last described piece lying on the SW
 side of the Cahoon river also the E¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ &
 E¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ and NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ of Sec 8 T20 R3 West
 also the NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ also the NW¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ of Sec
 9 T20 R3 West containing six hundred and
 sixty acres more or less And whereas at the time
 of his ^{death} said Eli Harold was dead all of the purch-
 ase money had not been paid And whereas since
 the death of the said Eli Harold the balance of said
 purchase money agreed to be paid by said Eli
 Harold in accordance to the sum of and then
 said dollars as same has been paid to the said
 party of the first part by the administrators of
 the said Eli Harold and out of assets of the estate
 of the said Eli so died the receipt thereof is hereby ack-
 nowledged the said party of the first part in consid-
 eration with his bond for title made to the said
 Eli Harold so died have granted & conveyed and
 by their power doth grant bargain sell and
 convey to the said party of the second part all
 of whom who along with the children of the said
 Eli Harold in died all of the above described
 land with the hindrances and appurtenan-
 ces thereto belonging to have and to hold as
 tenants in common in equal shares the same to
 the said party of the second part their heirs
 and assigns forever And for the said part
 of the first part will do for themselves and
 heirs administrators or executors warrant
 & will forever defend the title against all
 claimants to the same In testimony whereof
 on the said party of the first part the said
 John Dillay & Mary E. Ware have hereunto set our
 hands and affixed our seals this day and
 year first above written John Ward (Sgd)
 Signed sealed and delivered Mary E. Ware (Sgd)
 in our presence this the day
 of Jan'y 1839.
