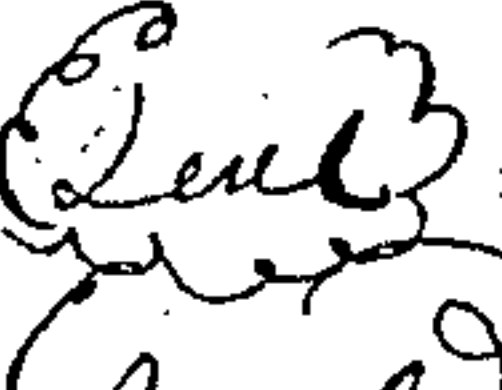
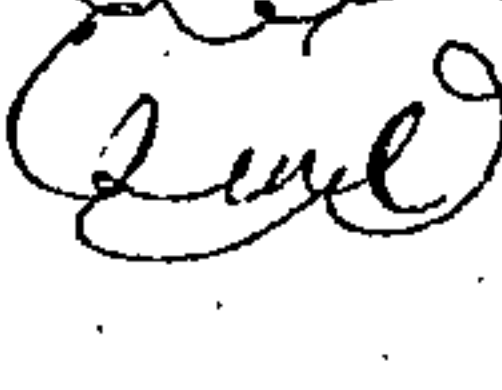

Hughart his wife of the first and the Shelby Coal Company of the second part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty five Dollars to us in hand paid at & before the delivering of these presents by the Shelby Coal Co. The Receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge we have this day bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said Shelby Coal Company the following described tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County & State aforesaid and in the Tuscaloosa land district known and described as follows (to wit) the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter & the South half of the South East Quarter of Section twenty two (22) and the South half of the South West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section twenty three (23) and West half of Fractional Section twenty six (26) and the East half of Fractional Section twenty seven (27) all in Township twenty two (22) of Range four west Containing in all Three hundred & two acres more or less together with all & singular the hereditaments & appertinances thereunto belonging to have unto the party of the second part their heirs & assigns forever and we the said party of the first part doth hereby covenant and agree with the said party of the second that at the time of the delivering hereof that we are lawfully seized of the premises & have good right & lawful authority to sell and

Convey the same in manner & form above stated and that we will warrant & defend the title to the same against all lawful claims & demands of all persons whatsoever.
