Shelly Harnett } these presents that
I Hasea Young being Justly Indebted to Evan
Johnson in the Sum of Three hundred &
Sixty dollars Secured by Eight promissory
Notes made on the 28th day of December 1858
& due Twelve months after date Each
Note for forty five dollars Each & The
Said Young being anxious & desirous to
Secure the Same has this day bargained
& sold & does by these presents bargain
sell & convey to the Said Evan Johnson
the N E 1/4 of Section 22 in Township 23 of
Range 15 E One hundred & Sixty Acres of
land more or less to have and to hold the
Same upon Trust so as to Secure the
payment of said Notes & if default be
made in the payment of their maturity
either in whole or in part then the Said
Evan Johnson shall and will proceed
to sell the afore described premises to
the highest bidder for Cash on giving
15 days Notice of the time & place of said
sale by advertisement and after paying all
of said Notes together with expenses of this
conveyance pay over to the Said Young the
balance if any. Nevertheless if the Said
Young pay all of said Notes at their ma-
turity then this to be void December 28th
1858
