 of South West quarter of Section thirty four
 in Township twenty of Range one East also
 the South East fourth of the South East fourth
 of Section thirty three in Township Twenty of
 Range one East also the South West quarter
 of South East quarter of Section thirty three
 in Township Twenty of Range one East also
 North West quarter of the South East quarter
