 Crop that with the said Isaac Kendrick may raise this
 year now the Condition of the above trust are such
 that if the said Isaac Kendrick fail to discharge the
 above debt on the 15 day of November next with
 interest from date then the said James E. Andrus
 shall have power to take possession of the
 Crop and dispose of the same at public
 Auction giving ten days notice at any
 place by him thought best or at least
 sell so much of it as will be of value su-
 fficient to satisfy said debt and pay the
