 the South West quarter of the North West quarter
 of the North West quarter of the North East
 quarter of Section eight in Township 24 of Range
 two East and also a portion of the North West
 quarter of the North West quarter of the same
 Section Township and Range to wit all of said
 last mentioned quarter quarter section which
 lies South of the following described line namely
 beginning at the South West Corner of the Mill
 Pond running thence North 42° East to the East
 line of said quarter quarter section and after
 -ing the same line from the beginning along the
 Mill dam across the Creek & from thence
 South 42° West to the West line of said quarter
 quarter section containing in all one hundred
 and thirty acres more or less lying and
 being in the County of Shelly and State of
 Alabama to have and to hold the same unto
 the said Hiram Butler his heirs and assy-
