 This Indenture made and Entered into this 12 day of July
 1859 between William Blair debtor of the 1st part &
 David W. McClanahan & Co. Creditor of the second part Wit
 respect that whereas the said party of the 1st part is
 justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the
 sum of Thirty four 41/100 dollars due by a promissory
 note dated 17 July 1855 due and payable one day
 after date with interest from 1 of January 1855
 and the said party of the 1st part being desirous to see
 the payment of said indebtedness for and in con-
 sideration thereof and for the further consideration of
 the sum of One dollar to the said party of the 1st part
 in hand paid by the said party of the 2nd part the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged the said party of
 the first part has sold and hereby sell & convey
 to the said party of the 2nd part the following
 described property to wit an old grey horse
 which said horse is now in the possession
 of said Blair to have and hold in trust
 as follows to wit it is hereby agreed that the
 said party of the first part is to have & retain
 possession of the said property until the 25
 day of December 1859 and if the said party of the
 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd
 part said debt with interest thereon and the
 reasonable expenses thereof by said 25th
 day of December 1859 then this Indenture
 to be null and void but upon default
 of said payment the said party of the second

part is hereby authorized to take into possession
 And sell said property to the highest bidder for
 Cash. After giving ten days notice of the time
 and place of said sale by advertisement put
 up at three public places and out of the
 proceeds of said sale retain the said sum of
 thirty four 41/100 dollars and interest thereon
 And the reasonable costs hereof And the balance of
 any pay due to said Blair given under our
 hands and seals this day and year above
 Written -
