

This indenture made this eleventh day of September 1858 between Didama Gamble of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama of the one part and William T Gamble Son of the said Didama Gamble of the second part Witnesseth that the said Didama Gamble as well for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which she the said Didama Gamble hath and beareth unto the said Didama Gamble as also for the better maintenance support and lively hood of him the said William T Gamble hath given granted and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant and confirm unto the said W. T. Gamble his heirs and assigns the following described land to wit a part of the South West 1/4 of Section five Township Twenty Three of Range Three (3) West commencing on the East and West line dividing lands with Eliza Whalley at the fork of the creek on the West side running North Ten Rods

to a Sycamore tree then ~~West~~ thirty Six
 Rods to the South Twelve Rods to the orig-
 inal Starting place. Containing two and
 76/100 Acres lying and being in Shelby County
 and Tuscaloosa land district together with
 all and singular The upper terrace thereunto
 belonging or in anywise appertaining to have
 & to hold unto the said party of the second
 part his heirs & assigns forever and said
 party of the first part doth covenant & agree that
 she will forever defend the title and possession
 of said land against the claim or demands
 of every person whatsoever In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the
