 Eighteen Range Two West containing one hund-
 red & sixty acres and twenty hundredth of an
 acre into the second part to have and to
 hold & to his heirs and assigns the said
 tract above described lands to have and to hold
 the same together with all the Rights priv-
 ileges immunities and appurtenances of what
 ever nature thereunto belonging unto the
 said party of the second part in witness
 whereof we have set our hands and
