And whereas the said F B Allen is desirous
of securing the payment of
these debts, and also the persons who
have become liable for him as ac-
cumbit of said debts as acceptors

endorsses or Securities against loss in case they
~~or either~~ of them should be compelled to pay
 any portion of their respective liabilities be
 fore the same can be provided for out of
 the means herein after conveyed in trust
 for that purpose. Saw therefore in consid-
 -eration of the premisses and the sum of Ten
 dollars to him in hand paid by the Said Lee
 & Sawyer Trustees to the Said F B Allen what
 this day granted bargained & sold & by these
 premisses doth grant bargain & sell unto
 the Said Lee & Sawyer Trustees the following
 described portions of his Real and personal
 property (viz) a certain piece of land lying
 in the Town of Mantwaile to wit the North
 East part of Lot 80 19 in the plan of Said
 Town Forty feet in width and Two hundred
 and Ninety Six feet in length being the same
 piece of land on which the Store house
 now occupied by Said Allen is situated
 together with all and singular the her-
 editaments & appurtenances thereunto belong-
 -ing or in any wise appertaining also all
 the goods wares & merchandise now on hand
 in said Store house amounting in value
 at cost as is supposed (in account of
 Said Stock having been taken as per) to the
 sum of about \$5.500 ^{00/100} together with all
 the notes and accounts due to him said

 Said Lee & Sawyer Trustees & that he will
 forever warrant and defend the title
 to the property hereby conveyed. This conveyance
 however is upon the following express
 Terms (viz) The Said Trustees shall take
 possession of said Store house & lot together
 - or with the Stock of goods wares and mer-
 -chandise now in hand in said Store

& hereby conveyed together with the notes
 and accounts contained in Schedule A"
 ofid. As soon as this deed is Executed
 They shall proceed immediately with such
 competent assistance as it may be nec-
 essary for them to employ for the pur-
 -pose to take an account of said goods
 wares & merchandise now on hand in said
 Store house stating the quantity of each
 article & its value in the usual manner
 of making out an account of Stock
 Said Trustees shall then give notice by
 publication in the Chronicle a news
 paper published in the County of Shelly
 that they will sell said goods wares
 & merchandise at private sale in said
 Store house at Cash for cash or good
 paper in short time. If said Stock is
 not all sold out in this manner at the
 end of sixty days from the execution of
 this deed, Said Trustees shall then af-
 -ter giving ten days notice of the time
 of sale offer said Remainder at public
 out cry to the highest bidder for cash or
 good notes or short credit as they may
 think most likely to secure the best
 prices. Said sale may be continued from
 day to day until the entire balance of
 said Stock not sold at private sale as
 aforesaid is disposed of. Said sale is to be
 conducted within the usual sale hours
 The Goods put up in such lots or quantities
 as will be likely to secure the best prices.
 The said Trustees shall also proceed to collect
 the notes and accounts conveyed to them by
 this deed with all convenient speed
 and they shall in all cases, if possible when
 said accounts are not paid on presentation
 close the same by notes payable to them as
 Trustees. And they are hereby authorised
 and requested to sue all claims which
 are now due if they are not promptly paid
 they are however authorised to exercise a sound
 discretion in this matter for the purpose of more
 effectually securing the payment of the
 debts hereby secured. If said Trustees sho-
 -uld be of opinion that the interests of the

secured by this deed will be furthered and the
 object of this Trust more certainly and speedily
 accomplished by a public sale as herein before
 provided of the remaining portion of said
 goods they are hereby authorized after having
 offered them as aforesaid at private sale for thirty
 days after the completion of the inventory or accou-
 nt of stock aforesaid to commence selling them
 at public auction in the manner and the terms herein
 before indicated they having first given the
 ten days notice of said sale herein before required
 this notice may be given by them in advance
 of the expiration of the thirty days if in their
 judgment they should think it best
 so that the Public Sale may commence
 at once on the expiration of the thirty days
 aforesaid the said Trustees shall keep
 the inventory of goods wares and merchandise
 to be made by them subject to the examination
 of any of the Parish to this deed or of any oth-
 er creditor of the grantor at all reasonable
 times, the said Trustees shall employ such
 competent persons to assist them as clerks
 and book keepers as may be necessary to
 execute this Trust faithfully & to the best
 advantage - they the said Trustees being
 responsible for their acting & doing in
 the premises and the expenses there in-
 curred together with each other expenses
 as may be necessary to the proper execution
 of this deed they are authorized to pay (the
 same being reasonable) out of the prop-
 erty or its proceeds which is hereby conveyed
 and the said Trustees shall apply the mon-
 ey as far as the same can be collected
 (less expenses as aforesaid) to the payment of the debts
 herein before specified pro rata and the said
 Trustees are to make said pro rata payments
 as soon and as often as the diligent execution
 of this Trust will enable them to do so
 and they are to take receipt or voucher
 for all payments showing the amount and
 time of payment in which account
 and by whom made the said
 Trustees shall advertise the sale of
 the Stone House and Lot aforesaid for
 thirty days in some news paper

& that sell the same at the door of said Store House at Public outcry for cash so according to the time of the advertisement within the usual sale hours - this sale to be made as soon as the Trust require it in the Judgment of said Trustees and the proceeds when collected shall be applied pro rata to payment of the debts hereinbefore enumerated & provided for in manner aforesaid - If after paying the debts in manner and form as herein provided there is any balance left in the hands of said Trustees the same shall be accounted for by them according to law to the Person or persons entitled by law to receive the same And the said Trustees are hereby clothed with all the powers & authority necessary & proper for the due and legal execution of this trust And the said Seedham Lee for himself & the said Reason B. Sawyer for himself covenants to and with the said H. B. Allen & with the said beneficiaries in this trust each of them to execute the same in good faith and to the best of their ability jointly & severally In witness whereof the parties said H. B.
