 1858. Between Willis E. Eliot of the County of Shelby

 of seven hundred dollars to me in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
 sold and delivered and by these presents do
 bargain sell and deliver unto the said
 Charles F. Eliot a certain tract or parcel of land
 known as $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $S\frac{1}{4}$ $E\frac{1}{4}$ of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ $W\frac{1}{4}$ and
 the $S\frac{1}{4}$ of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ $W\frac{1}{4}$ and the $S\frac{1}{4}$ of the

to hold the above bargained or conveyed premises
with all the appurtenance thereto belonging, or
in anywise appertaining and to be free from my
heirs Exors admors and assigns for ever and
free from the claims of the United States
and free from all manner of Person or persons
claiming in the author by or under the
same whether in law or Equity in witness
