 18th day of February 1839 between William
 Spearman debtor of the first part and Bell
 Robertson Creditor of the second part Witnesseth
 That whereas the said party of the 1st part is justly
 indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the sum
 of fifty five dollars & 47/100 due by promissory
 note and payable as is before the 1st day of
 January 1860 and the said party of the 1st part
 being desirous to secure the payment of said
 indebtedness for and in consideration thereof and
 for the further consideration of the sum of one
 dollar to the said party of the 1st part in hand
 paid by the said party of the second part the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said
 party of the 1st part has sold and hereby sells
 and conveys to the said party of the 2nd part
 the following described property to wit and fully
 more or less of several Colles with a black jack
 two grand old and a one horse wagon to
 have and to hold in trust as follows It is hereby
 agreed that the said party of the 1st part to
 have and retain possession of the said
 property until the 1st day of January 1860
 and the said party of the 1st part
 shall fully pay to the said party of the

The first said debt with interest thereon and the reasonable expenses hereof by said 1st day of January 1860 thus this condition is to be null and void. But upon default of such payment the said Part of the said part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving two days notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement posted up at three public places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain said sum of Fifty dollars and the interest thereon and the reasonable costs hereof and the balance of any sum to the said party of the 1st part.
