

This indenture made and entered into the
 5th day of March A.D. 1839 between Henry &
 Matthew the first part and George Belors
 of the second part and Clay Belors of the
 third part all of the County and State of
 Alabama Whereas the said party of the
 first part is justly indebted unto the said
 party of the second part in the sum of
 forty three and 50/100 dollars due 1st day of
 January 1860 by two notes in writing bear-
 ing date unto these presents Now these
 for Manifests that the said party of the
 first part being anxious and desirous
 of securing the payment of said notes
 unto the said party of the said first
 in consideration thereof of the further
 consideration of one dollar to one in hand
 paid by the said party of the second part
 doth Grant bargain sell and convey and
 by these presents have granted bargain
 sold and sold unto the said party of the
 third part the following Land to wit the
 South half of the South East quarter of Sec
 30 and the West of the West of Section 35
 in Township 8 N. of Range 13 East Con-
 taining one hundred Ninety 49/100 acres
 to have and to hold unto the said party
 of the third part his heirs and assigns
 forever together with the land and appur-
 tenances thereto belonging in trust
 Manifests that if the said party of the first
 part shall pay as cause to be paid the
 full amount of the above and before
 mentioned notes with interest and as by the
 first day of January 1860 Then this deed
 of trust is to be null and void But if
 the said party of the first part fails to
 pay as cause to be paid by the first day
 of January 1860 The said party of the
 third part is hereby authorized and im-
 powered to take possession of the said
 lands herein described and sell the
 same to the highest bidder for cash in
 the Town of Monticello upon first giving
 twenty days notice by writing Two or
 more written notices in public places in
 Shelby County and to execute the foregoing

of said Sale to the satisfaction of those due
 of trust and the residue to the said party
 of the first part in testimony whereof
