

This indenture made and entered into this twenty
 sep day of May Eighteen hundred and fifty per
 Victorius Jordan Jones and his wife Lucy Jones of the
 County of Shelby and State of Alabama of the one part
 & Lawrence L. Jones of the County and State aforesaid
 of the other part Witnesseth that Jordan and Lucy
 Jones for and in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred Dollars to them in hand paid the right
 (which is hereby acknowledged) that this day began
 and sold and conveyed and by these presents doth
 bargain sell and convey unto the said L. L. Jones
 all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and
 known as the North East quarter of the North East
 quarter and the North West quarter of the North East
 quarter all in Section one Township twenty two of
 Range Two West Containing Eighty acres more or
 less in the District of Land Subject to Sale at
 Tuscaloosa Alabama Together with all and sing-
 ular the appurtenances heretofore and right in
 any wise appertaining unto the said L. L. Jones
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Jordan & Lucy Jones for themselves their heirs
 executors and administrators doth warrant
 and well ever defend the right and title to
 the above described and hereby conveyed
 premises the said L. L. Jones his heirs

and assigns power and against the claim of them
 the said Gordin and Lucy Bonis and also against
 the lawful title or demand of all and every person
 or persons claiming or holding under or by them
 the said Gordin and Lucy Bonis and also against
 the lawful title claim or demand of all and every
 person or persons claiming or holding under the
 General Government of the United States of America
