 to him in hand paid the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged that they day bargain-
 ed and sold and by these presents doth
 give grant bargain and sell to said party
 of the second part the following described
 parcel or lot of Land to wit The S.W. 1/4
 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 30 & Township 21 Range
 3 West also the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 30
 Township 21 Range 3 West Containing eighty
 acres more or less to have and hold the
 same said said Woods for himself
 his heirs executors and assigns with
 Warrent and defend the right and
 title of the above described premises
