 Shelby County Whereas I Thos McGhee
 did on the 17th day of February execute a
 deed of trust as follows to Columbus Cum-
 mingham of the State & County of said and
 John West being the trustee in said deed
 as mortgage on the following property all
 being in Shelby County & State of said
 to wit This 1/4 of the 8 1/4 of the 36 Township
 20 Range & West also the 1/4 of S E 1/4 of Section
 36 Township & West containing one hundred
 and forty acres more or less being the
 land upon the said Thos McGhee
 now residing and yoke of Oxen of red
 Collar and Road Wagon one bay horse
 and several horses, but some of the
 cows & calves two of the calves being dead I also
 sold convey to the said Columbus Cunningham for
 value received one red cow one speckled
 bull one red steer and one white heifer
 & twenty five bushels Corn more or less and
 delivered to him at the present time all
 the property that is here described as
 contained in said deed The deed having
 been executed by me to the said Colum-
 bus Cunningham for the sum of Four
 hundred & fifty Dollars for which I agree
 to him my note due 1st of December
 after date he still holds the deed and my
 consent so to do in the said Columbus
 Cunningham has by day paid me one
 hundred & fifty Dollars over & above the
 amt of the 1/4 of the land described
 upon which I delivered him all of the

property herein mentioned & the said Thomas
 J. McGhee & Martha McGhee the wife of
 the said Thomas J. McGhee further agree
 with the said Columbus Leitchman that
 he has the exclusive right to dispose of
 all the property hereinabove both real
 and personal & that they relinquish their
 right to redemption in the sale of the land
 & testimony and hereto set our
 hands & seals this March the 30th 1839
