

This indenture made and entered into this 13th day
 of April 1839 between Henry B. Horton of the first
 part and William M. Allen of the second part
 witnesseth that whereas the said party of the first
 part is indebted to the person of Allen Rushin & Co.
 now due the sum of Seven hundred dollars and
 the said party of the first part being in need
 of Supplies for his family of day Goods and
 Groceries which he is unable to pay for as he is
 unable the necessity of getting them now in consid-
 eration of the said indebtedness due and the
 account running for the present year and the
 promises upon the part of said Allen Rushin
 & Co that they will from time to time during the
 present year furnish to him the said Hor-
 ton such day Goods and Groceries as he
 may need the said H. B. Horton hereby sells and
 conveys to the said William M. Allen his present
 growing Crop and to be planted all the wheat now
 growing Cotton to be planted Corn planted and to
 be planted to have and to hold in trust as follows
 the said Horton binds himself to cultivate said
 Crop Harvest said Wheat and have it thrashed
 gather said Cotton and Corn and if the said
 Horton shall by the 1st day of September
 next fully pay the said Allen Rushin &
 all of said debt including debt now due and
 that which shall be made by the purchasing such
 Supplies as he may need during the year
 then this obligation to be void but upon the
 failure thus to pay he binds himself
 to deliver to said William M. Allen said
 Wheat Cotton and Corn and the said William
 M. Allen is hereby authorized to sell said
 Wheat Corn and Cotton to the highest bidder
 for cash after giving twenty days notice of
 by advertisement posted up at three public
 places in Shelby County and out of
 the proceeds of said sale pay said debt in
 full and the balance if any due to said
 Horton given under my hand and seal
 this day and year above written
 H. B. Horton
