

The State of Alabama This indenture made and
 Shelby County 3 entered into this 16th day of April
 1839 between Casso Nevins debtor of the first part
 and Miles H. Pope Creditor of the second part
 Witnesseth That Whereas the said party of the 1st
 part is justly indebted to the party of the 2^d
 part in the sum of one hundred & 34/100 dollars
 due by promissory note of some date herewith
 bearing interest from date and payable by the
 1st day of December 1839 and the said party
 of the 1st part being desirous to secure the pay-
 ment of said indebtedness for and in consideration
 thereof and for the further consideration of the
 sum of one dollar to the said party of the
 first part in hand paid by the said
 party of the 2^d part the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged the said party of the
 1st part has sold and hereby sells and con-
 veys to the said party of the 2^d part the
 following described Property to wit one

White meadows also the Crop of Cotton raised by
 the said Jesse the present year on the farm
 known as the Hubbard Old place in the 16th
 Section of Township 21 Range 11 East now
 owned by said Jesse & his Mother to have
 and to hold in trust as follows: It is hereby
 agreed that the said party of the 1st part
 is to have and retain possession of the said
 property until the 1st day of December 1839
 and if the said party of the 2nd part shall
 fully pay to the said party of the 1st part said
 debt with interest thereon and the reasonable
 expenses hereof by said 1st day of December
 1839 then this Subenture is to be null and
 void But upon default of such payment to the
 said party of the 2nd part is hereby authorized
 to take into possession and sell said property
 to the highest bidder for cash after giving
 twenty days notice of the time and place
 of said sale by advertisement posted up at
 those public places and out of the proceeds
 of said sale to pay the said sum of one
 hundred 34th 100 dollars and interest thereon
 and the reasonable costs hereof and the balance
 if any pay to the said party of the 1st
 part Given under our hands and seals this
 day and year above written Jesse Keim *JS*
 Wm H Pope *JS*
