 second part witnesses that the party of the first
 part in consideration of the sum of one thousand
 & ninety nine \$1000 dollars of \$1099.97/100 to him in hand
 paid the account which is hereby acknowledged
 hath granted bargained & sold and by these
 presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the
 said party of the second part the following dis-
 -covered land situated in the County of Shelby for
 said (viz) The South East quarter of the North East
 quarter the South West quarter of the North East quarter
 the South half of the North West quarter the South
 West quarter & North half of South East quarter of
 Section one Township 24 Range 11 East the South
 East quarter of Section two Township 24 Range 11
 East & all of Section six Township 24 Range 12 East
 & all the interest which vested in Lewis E Parsons
 by a deed from Daniel W. Proutie & A. F. Proutie
 (his wife) on the 25th August 1838 to him in Sections
 19 20 29 & 30 of Township 24 Range 4 West To have
 & to hold unto the said Alacama Coal Mining
 Company forever in fee simple and the said
 party of the first part first in consideration of the
 purchase of \$1099.97/100 to him paid by the
 said Alacama Coal Mining Co as aforesaid
 doth convey only such title to said Ala Coal
 Mining Co as vested in said party of the
 first part by virtue of a deed made to him
 by Daniel W. Proutie & A. F. Proutie (his wife)
 on the 25th August 1838 for lands aforesaid
