 the said party of the first part has sold
 and hereby sell and conveys to the said
 party of the second part the following
 described property to wit land south
 west 1/4 of North East 1/4 the North
 East 1/4 of south East 1/4 the south
 East 1/4 of south East 1/4 section 16 Town
 ship 18 Range 1 East containing one
 hundred and twenty acres more or
 less and 2 year old Keiper Ten head of
 goats and subbords one clock one bedstead
 and bed and 1/2 cradle to have and
 to have in trust as follows it is hereby
 agreed that the said party of the first
 part do have and retain possession
 of the said property until the 25 day
 of December 1862 and if the said
 party of the first part shall fully pay
 to the said party of the second part
 said debt with interest thereon and
 the reasonable expenses hereof by said
 25 day of December 1862 then this
