Shelby County, William Roper of the State & County above-
said do hereby donate to my son Harmon S. Roper to him and
to his heirs and assigns for their own use and benefit the
following described land lying in Shelby County and State of
Ala. to wit: The East half of the North West Quarter of Section 31 and
Township 19 Range 1 East to have & to hold to the said party of the
second part his heirs and assigns forever the above described
and hereby granted land and premises and the said party
of the first part hereby covenants with the said party of the
second part that he is lawfully seized of and has good
right to donate & convey said land and hereby binds myself
my heirs and legal Representatives forever to warrant and defend
the title to said land & premises to the said party of the second
part his heirs & assigns legal Representatives against the claim
of all and every person in law or equity and against
the Government of the United States.
