this 24<sup>th</sup> day of June 1859 between George J. Mason  
& C. A. Mason husband and wife of the first part  
and Ruckus Walls of the other part all of the County  
& State aforesaid. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration  
of the sum of fifty dollars to them in hand paid  
by said Walls the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged said Mason and wife have given  
granted bargained and sold & these presents  
do grant bargain and sell to said Walls the

following described lot or parcel of land  
and known as follows to wit. The East End  
of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 6 T 22. R. 1. E to wit  
running into said lot from the E. towards the  
West one hundred and ten yards. Containing ten  
Acres more or less to have and to hold to said  
Walls and his heirs forever. The land aforesaid  
and we Covenant with said Walls that we  
are lawfully seized of the land aforesaid that  
we have a good right to bargain and sell the  
land aforesaid & that we will forever warrant  
and defend the title to said land to said Walls  
and his heirs forever against us and our heirs  
and all other persons forever. Witness our
