Shelby County } This Indenture made and entered
into this the twenty third day of August eighteen hundred
and fifty nine. by & between Eliza S. Reese and
James T. Reese, her husband. of the county and
State aforesaid parties of the first part and George
A Logan party of the second part: Witnesseth. That
the parties of the first part for and in consideration of
the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to them in hand
paid, by the party of second. at & before the signing
sealing & delivering of these presents. the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. have granted bargained
sold. & conveyed, and by these presents do bargain
grant. sell. & convey unto the party of the second part
his heirs & assigns forever the following lot or parcel
of Land, lying and being in the Town of Montevallo
Shelby County. Ala. To wit: One Acre more or less
off the North West corner of Lot No. (6) according to the
plan of said Town & founded as at present enclosed
the dwelling lot fronting on Middle Street, and which
is the same lot which was conveyed by J. B. Wilson.
A. M. Wilson Geo. D. Shortridge and E. Shortridge to said
Eliza S. Reese. on the 19 January 1858. & which is
described in the deed made by them of that date. together
with all & singular the lands. tenements. hereditaments.
rights and appurtenances thereto belonging. To have
& to hold, unto the party of the second part his heirs and
assigns forever. And the party of the first part, for
themselves their heirs. Executors & administrators. do
hereby covenant to & with the party of the second part
that they are the lawfull owners of said premises & have a
good right to convey the same. and that they will defend
and forever defend. unto the title to the same. against
the claim of themselves, and of all persons whomsoever.

and seals. the day and year date above written.
