 Kenan, their heirs and assigns, my right of Power
 in and to the lands hereafter specified, to the extent
 of the interest conveyed in the same lands to the said
 Gardener, Lapsley, & Kenan by my husband Dr.
 Lemuel J. Hale by deed executed by and between
 him and the said Gardener, Lapsley and Kenan
 bearing date the 30th day of July 1857. to which
 deed at reference be made. so as to leave the interests
 of the said Gardener, Lapsley and Kenan in said
 lands free and unaffected by my right and Power
 that is to say. The North East quarter of the North
 West quarter of Section five, Township twenty four
 and Range thirteen east. and the North East West
 quarter of the North East quarter and the East
 half of the North East quarter, and the Southeast
 quarter of the North East quarter; and the South
 East fraction (except forty acres of the east end thereof
 which belongs to Hiram Butler) all of Section twenty
 four. in Township twenty two and Range three west
 all of said lands being in the County aforesaid in the
 district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama
