Know all men by these presents that we Wm Jordan & Sarah Ann Jordan wife of said William of the State of Mississippi. the said Sarah Ann being a Daughter of the late Capt Mil J Horton D.C. and one of the heirs of Estate of said Dec^d have made nominated constituted & appointed & do by these presents make. nominate constitute & appoint Minor J Horton of Shelby County Alabama our true lawfull agent & attorney for us & in our name

or in the name of the said Sarah Ann Jordan to recover of the Administrator of the estate of said Minn J. Horton Dec^r, any & all sum or sums of money that may be due owing & found to be coming to the said Sarah Ann Jordan, from estate of said Dec^r, as one of the heirs thereof, as well as bear the same from the Judge of Probate of said Shelby County in case the money may by the representatives of Estate of said Dec^r be paid over to him, either before at the time of, or after partial or final Settlement of said estate as the same may become due to her and upon receipt of any sum to give receipts therefor either partial or ~~final~~ in full as the same may be made paid & the same as received to pay over to Jefferson Holly of said County and notes held by said Holly given by said Wm Jordan with security for the purchase money of a Negro Girl bought by said Sarah Ann Jordan of said Holly, until the S^r liability to said Holly discharges the balance if any return to account to the said Sarah Ann Jordan for also the said Minn J. Horton is fully authorized to act as agent of said Wm Jordan in collecting from all any & all others, that may in any wise be indebted to either the said Wm Jordan or the said Sarah Ann Jordan or both & to apply the same in the same way accounting to us alone for the balance that may be in hand after discharging the liability named.
