That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which he the said James Hodgens hath and beareth unto the said David N Hodgens his son, as also for the better maintenance and livelihood of him the said

David N Hodgens hath given granted and confirmed, and by these presents doth give grant and confirm unto the said David N Hodgens his heirs and assigns the following described land to wit: The South East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter and the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter and North West Quarter of South East Quarter of Section No Eight in Township No 22 of Range four West. Containing One Hundred & Sixty Acres & 30/100. Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold unto the said David N Hodgens his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part, will forever warrant and defend the title to said land unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of any person whatsoever in law or Equity.
