any 1860. between Joseph & Gregg and Lucinda Gregg
husband and wife of the first part. and Henderson W-
Nelson of the second part. witnesseth: That whereas the said
Henderson W Nelson has this day become the security for
the said parties of the first part, by joining with them in
a bond for two thousand dollars conditioned for the
faithful performance of said parties of the first part as
guardian for Francis A. Blount payable to John W
McClanahan Judge of Probate for Shelby County. State
of Alabama, and the said parties of the first part
being desirous to secure the said Henderson W Nelson
as such security, for and in consideration of the
premises and the further consideration of five dollars
to said parties of the first part in hand paid by the
said Henderson W Nelson the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged the said parties of the first part hereby
sells and conveys unto the said Henderson W Nelson
a Negro Woman Delia about Eighteen years of age.
to have and to hold in trust as follows. the said parties
of the first part are to retain the possession of said Negro
until default be made in said bond, and in the
event said Henderson W Nelson shall be made liable
on said Bond, or be put to trouble or Expense by reason
of said bond, then, and in that event the said Henderson
W Nelson is hereby authorized to take said Negro Woman
into possession and sell her at public Sale, for cash-
after giving thirty days, by advertisement posted up at
three public places in this (Shelby) County, and out of
the proceeds of Sale retain and pay all costs, damages
and expenses which may arise by reason by reason
of said bond and the balance if any, pay to the said
parties of the first part. and should said parties of the
first part so do and discharge the duties required
of them as such Guardian or otherwise indemnify
said Henderson W Nelson then this obligation to be
