into this 23^d day of January 1860 between A. Moore debtor
of the first part and Eli A. Bently Creditor of the second
part. witnesseth: That whereas the said party of the first
part has become security for the party of the second part
in the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars or the return
of two Horses to George McGowan by 20th day of Decr.
1860 and the said party of the first part being desirous
to become the party of 2^d part as security for and in cons-
ideration thereof. And for the further Consideration of
the sum of one dollar to the said party of the first part
in hand paid by the party of the second part the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged. the said party of the first
part has sold and hereby sells and conveys to the
said party of the second. the following described to wit

I hereby agree to transfer the debt
to George McClanahan on 4 July 1860
E. J. Brantley

All of my Crop of Corn and Cotton. Except $\$35^00$ rent reserved for
J Roper to be raised and grown by me this year on the
following described land The $\frac{N}{2}$ of the $\frac{E}{4}$ of Section 34
Township 21. Range 1. West. to have and to hold in trust
as follows. It is hereby agreed that the said party of
the first part is to have and retain possession of the said
property until the 20 day of December 1860. and if the
said party of the first part shall fully secure the said party
of the second part as said security and the reasonable
expenses hereof, by said 20 day of December 1860. then this
Indenture to be null and void. But upon default of
such payment the said party of the second part is hereby
authorized to take into possession and sell said property
to the highest bidder for Cash after giving ten days
notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement
posted up at three public places and out of the proceeds
of said sale retain the said sum of two hundred fifty
dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable costs
hereof and the balance if any pay to the said party of
the first part
