 granted lands and premises. And the said parties  
 of the first part husband and wife hereby covenant  
 with the said party of the second part that we are  
 lawfully seized of and have good right to sell and  
 convey said land. And hereby bind ourselves, our  
 heirs and legal representatives forever, to warrant  
 and defend the title to said land and premises to  
 the said party of the second part his heirs, assigns and  
 legal representatives, against the claims of all and  
 every person in law or Equity and against the govern-
