

 Shelby County } This Indenture made this the 29th day
 of October A.D. 1859 by and between John L. Bassett and G. C.
 Bassett his wife of the first part and William W. Tambor of the
 second part witnesseth That the said party of the first part for
 and consideration of the sum of Three thousand Dollars to him
 in hand paid by the party of the second part at and before
 the delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged have bargained sold and granted by these Presents
 do bargain sell and grant an undivided interest of one
 third part unto the party of the second part and to his heirs
 and assigns forever the following described property to wit
 Five Mules and two Waggon Valued at \$950 Eight Work Oxen and
 two Carts valued at \$425 One Circular Saw mill and Corn
 Grish mill with all the fixtures compleat Valued at \$4,000 One set
 of Blacksmith Tools Carpenters Tools wrenches &c &c Valued at
 \$370 making together the sum of \$5,745 and also the following
 lands lying in Shelby County in the State of Alabama
 to wit the SW 1/4 N 1/4 of S 1/4 & the NE 1/4 of S 1/4 of Sec 19 -
 the NW 1/4 S 1/2 of S 1/4 & the SE 1/4 of Sec 35

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 31 All in Township
 twenty Range two East also the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 24, the
 NE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 25, (the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, the S $\frac{1}{2}$
 of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 36) all in Township
 twenty Range One East in the District of land subject to sale at
 Tuscaloosa Alabama containing in all 1600 Acres more or less
 to have and to hold a one third undivided interest in the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of land together with all and singular the
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining unto the sole and proper use of behoof
 and benefit of the party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 in fee simple. The condition of the above deed is upon the express
 condition that whereas the said Bassit is greatly indebted to the
 said Hambo in the sum of three thousand dollars payable as
 follows: by three several promissory notes bearing even date
 with these presents, each for one thousand dollars the first
 payable on the first day of January 1860 the second on the first
 day of January 1861 and the third on the first day of January
 1862, the above notes given for property described in this Deed
 Whereas also the said Hambo has become security for said
 Bassit on two notes bearing like dates with these presents and
 payable to E M Perrins on the first day of January 1861 for one
 thousand and sixty three $\frac{63}{100}$ dollars with interest from the first
 day of January 1860 the other payable to L M Hill on the first
 day of January 1861 for two hundred and seventy one $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars
 dollars with interest from the first day of January 1860. And
 being willing and desirous to secure the payment to said
 Hambo of said three thousand dollars due as aforesaid and
 also to secure him against the payment of the said notes to
 said Perrins and Hill. Now the condition of the above deed is
 such that the said Bassit shall well and truly pay or cause
 to be paid the said several promissory notes above described to the
 persons to whom they are due and at the respective times they
 fall due and shall well and truly save harmless the said Hambo
 from all harm costs expenses or trouble about said notes
 then and in that event the abn deed is to be null & void
 otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
