Shelby County I know all men by these Presents that an order of the last Orphans Court of said County was made on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1848 authorizing and advertising a sale of the real estate of William Gilbert late of said County dec<sup>d</sup>, including that part thereof which had been assigned & allotted to the widow of said dec<sup>d</sup>, as dower which said part however remaining unsold until the death of the widow of said William Gilbert dec<sup>d</sup>, an order of the Probate Court of said County was made on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1855 advising & requiring the Administration Thos H. Brusher to proceed and sell that part thereof in pursuance of the previous order of said Court In obedience to which said order I Thomas H. Brusher as Administrator of the estate of William Gilbert dec<sup>d</sup>, did on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1856 at the late residence of said dec<sup>d</sup>, in said County after due and legal notice sell the same that part of the real estate of said dec<sup>d</sup> which had been assigned and allotted to the widow as dower being the North End of the W.<sup>1/2</sup> of the S.E.<sup>1/4</sup> of Section 21 Township 18 of Range One West. Sixty Eight acres. also the North end of the E.<sup>1/2</sup> of the S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> of same Section Township and Range Twenty acres. also the E.<sup>1/2</sup> of the N.W.<sup>1/4</sup> & N.<sup>1/2</sup> of the N.E.<sup>1/4</sup> of same Section Township and Range and all of that part of the E.<sup>1/2</sup> of the N.E.<sup>1/4</sup> of same Section Township and Range which lies West of a line commencing at a large Red Oak marked X which is at the SW Corner of said half quarter running S 61° E across said half quarter & the Valley Two hundred and eighty acres more or less to J. J. Byers for the sum of Thirty two hundred dollars, on a credit of one two & three years, with interest thereon from the day of said sale which said sum of money having been secured by the said Byers notes & security, and a report thereof made to the Probate Court of said County and said sale by said Court in all things confirmed, and said Byers having assigned and transferred all the rights and interests which he had of in and to said tract of land by reason of his said purchase and the full payment of the purchase money and having joined with this administrator in a petition praying an order of the Court of Probate of said County authorizing this administrator to make title to said tracts of land to his said assignee Peter Deshazo and said Probate Court having made said order now I the said Thomas H. Brusher as administrator of the Estate of William Gilbert dec<sup>d</sup>, in consideration

of the premises as well as in obedience to the order of said Probate Court of said County have sold and do now by these Presents sell convey and confirm unto the said Peter Deshazo assignee of the said J. J. Byers all the right title interest claim and demand which the said William Gilbert dec<sup>d</sup>, at the time of his death, had, or in and to the said tract of land, to have and to hold the same to himself, his heirs and assigns forever In witness of which I hereby set my hand and seal as aml. as aforesaid this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1858 T.
