 sixteenth day of February 1860 between Shelby King
 the Creditor Janus J. Pierce trustee and Calvin M Harris
 the debtor witnesseth that the said Calvin M Harris
 is justly indebted to said King the sum of One hundred
 and eighteen and $\frac{5}{8}$ or Dollars due the fifteenth of October
 next which debt the said Harris is willing and desirous
 to secure, hath this day and date above mentioned, granted
 bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Shelby King One hundred
 and Fifty Bushels of Corn that he makes in the year
 eighteen hundred and Sixty and his entire Crop of
 Cotton for the year 1860 and also Twelve head of Cattle
 that now in the possession of said Harris at his premises.
 The above mentioned property is intended to secure the
 payment of the debt aforesaid and this deed is made
 for that purpose and it is hereby agreed between the said
 Harris and the said Janus J. Pierce that if the said
 sum of money is not paid to the said King by the time
 said debt is due that the said Harris shall so soon
 thereafter as the said King shall direct take possession of
 said property above mentioned and proceed to sell the
 same for cash after having given thirty days notice by adver-
 tisement at three public places in said County. The sale
 to be made at the said Harris house or at Montevallo which
 ever the said trustee may think proper And from the proceeds
 of said sale to satisfy and pay over to the said King
 the said sum of money and all other necessary expenses
 and any surplus that may be over the said King is to
 pay it over to the said Harris
