 thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the  
 said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged, have sold and hereby sell  
 confirm and convey unto the said party of the second  
 part the following described land lying in Shelby  
 County State of Alabama to wit: The lot of land in  
 Columbiana known as the stable lot which said  
 Parnell purchased of the said Reinhardt being  
 the same as now inclosed and of the following size  
 viz the E side is 15 Poles & 7 links the S side 9 Poles & 5  
 links the W side 16 poles & 5 links and the N side 10 Poles & 17  
 links to have and to hold to said second party his  
 heirs and assigns forever, the above described and  
 hereby granted land, and premises. And the parties  
 husband and wife, hereby covenant with the party  
 of the second part that we are lawfully seized of  
 and have good right to sell and convey, said land  
 and hereby bind ourselves, our heirs and legal  
 representatives forever to warrant and defend the  
 title to said land and premises to the said party  
 of the second part his heirs and assigns and legal  
 representatives, against the claim of all and every  
 person in law or Equity and against the government
