property, One red sided Cow 1 pair of Steers Yearling
marked cross in the right & Swallow fork in the
left Thane and a hold to secure the payment
of said demand. The condition of the above
obligation is this, if the said Glascock fails
on his part to pay the above described note when
due then the said Murray to sell said property
to the highest for cash after giving 10 days notice
by advertisement and pay to said Glascock
the Overplus after satisfying said demands
with costs &c if any. but if Glascock does comply
and pay said demands when due then this
obligation to be void. }
