into this 29 day of November AD 1859 between Elizabeth
C Wilson and Maria D Wilson husband and wife

of the first part, and Joseph A Ferguson of the second part, witness; That the said parties of the first part, for and consideration of the sum of four thousand six hundred & twenty six dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and hereby sell, confirm and convey, unto the said party of the second part the following described land lying in Shelby County, State of Alabama to wit the South East fourth of Section Ten, the South West fourth of Section Eleven, the North West fourth of Section Eleven, except two acres thereof to be laid off in the N W Corner so as to cover & include the Camp ground & grave yard at Chapel the N W 1/4 of N E 1/4 of Section Eleven, the S W 1/4 of S E 1/4 of Section Two and the N 1/2 of the S E 1/4 of Section Two excepting & reserving also the right of way 100 feet for the use of the Ala & Tenn River Rail Road where it passes over any of said land in Township 21 Range 1 E & have and hold to said second party his heirs & assigns forever, the above described and hereby granted lands and premises. And the said parties of the first part, husband and wife, hereby covenant with the said party of the second part that we are lawfully seized of and have good right to sell and convey, said land and hereby bind ourselves our heirs & legal representatives forever to warrant and defend the title to said land & premises to the said party of the second part his heirs assigns and legal representatives, against the claim of all and every person in law or Equity and against the government of the United States Given under our hands and seals this day & year above written
