Shelby County } This Indenture made this 20th day of March in year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & Fifty between Thomas D Woods of the first part and Almoth Woods Trustee of second part and Thomas A Woods of the third part all of the County and State aforesaid. witnesseth: That where as the said Thomas D Woods is indebted to the said Thomas A Woods in the sum of one hundred dollars by one note of hand dated 20th day of March 1860 and due the 1st day of January 1861. Like said Thomas D Woods have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Almoth Woods Trustee for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Thomas D Woods by the said Almoth Woods in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivery these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following property to wit One Bay Horse with one eye. between eight & Ten years old, One two horse Waggon. One small spoke of oxen. & Thomas D Woods do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend unto the said Almoth Woods a good & lawful right to the property herein described against all and every person in whatsoever in trust. Nevertheless should the said Thomas D Woods pay or cause to be paid to the said Thomas A Woods the above described note on or before the 1st day of Jan'y 1861. then this obligation to be void & of no effect; but should the said Thomas D Woods fail to pay the said note or sum

of money heretofore described on or before the 1st of January 1861 in that case the said Almoth Woods. Trustee may proceed to sell the said property herein described at the place the said Thomas D Woods now lives to the highest bidder for cash after first giving ten days notice of said sale at three public places in said County and then the said Almoth Woods shall apply the proceeds of the payment of said note herein described with interest thereon and should there be a balance after paying said note and all expenses he shall pay said amt whatever it maybe to the said Thomas D Woods.
