 by reason of their Securityship as aforesaid. Now
 therefore in Consideration of the premises this said
 Henry J. Sawyer has & does hereby sell assign
 transfer and set over to the said Wilie H. Pope &
 Thomas H. Brasher all the Costs owing and coming
 to the said Henry J. Sawyer as late Sheriff of Shelby
 County Ala. in the Circuit Court of said County and
 hereby authorize and empower them to collect
 said Costs & to receipts for the same. Witness my
