desirous to secure the said A W Coe by giving  
the A W Coe at a loss on the following property the  
whole of his Cotton Crop Now if the said Will M  
fails to pay the above named debt one or by the  
first day of March next the said A W Coe  
shall have power to take charge of said prop-  
erty and dispose of it at public auction  
Giving ten days notice at any place they  
may think best in testimony whereof I have
