 next One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine for
 a certain piece of land lying and situated as follows
 North 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 Section No 6 Township No 11 Range No 10 E.
 Containing 80 Acres in the District of Tuscaloosa State of

Alabama Shelby County and if the above Seander M Hall
doth will and faithfully fulfill said Conditions then this
Obligation to be null and void otherwise to remain in
full force and virtue in law and equity
