 November 1861. between Henry Newman of the first
 part and of Newman & Bro of the second part witnesses
 that the said party of the first part for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of one hundred and ninety dollars
 to them in hand paid by the said party of the
 second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have sold and hereby sell confirm and convey unto
 said party of the second part the following described
 lands lying in Shelby County state of Ala to wit
 E 1/2 of the S W 1/4 section 10 of 18 R 1 East containing
 eighty acres more or less to have and to hold to the
 said second parties their heirs and assigns forever
 the above described lands and premises and the said
 party of the first part hereby covenants with the
 said party of the second part that we are lawfully
 seized and have good right to sell & convey said
 lands and hereby bind myself my heirs and legal
 representatives forever to warrant and defend the
 title to said lands & premises to the said parties of
 the second part his heirs and assigns & legal
 representatives against the claim of all persons
 in law or Equity and against the government
 of the United States
