 granted bargained & sold and by these presents do give
 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William
 Barty and to his heirs and assigns forever the following
 described land to wit the North East quarter of the North
 West quarter and North West quarter of North West quarter
 in section twentyth also the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of South East $\frac{1}{4}$
 in section 18 all in township twenty four (24)
 Range thirteen 13 East lying and being in the
 county of Shelby state of Ala to the said William
 Barty and to his heirs and assigns forever for their
 own use and benefit to have and to hold and the
 title of which we warrant and forever defend and
 bind our heirs and assigns to warrant and forever
 defend unto the said William Barty and to his
 heirs and assigns forever against all lawful
 claims of any any and all persons whatever
