excepting One Acre including the grain yard on the
top of the Hill I also convey twenty acres in the NE
Corner of Sec 4 T99 R 1 E to him and to hold to
the said James & Leah Ford and the heirs of said Leah
forever provided the said James & Leah Ford and
the survivors of them keep clothed feed Cattle &c
and my wife the said Leah during our natural lives
but should they fail so to do it is hereby & preps
by agreed & understood and hereby provided that
said land is to revert to me and my wife & heirs
and they deed Our such failure to be held & considered
a nullity witness my hand and seal this 12 day
Novr 1861 Shadley Deek Ford
