 for and in consideration of the mutual love and affection
 I have for my son Franklin King who is now
 twenty one years of age. I have this day given
 granted and conveyed and by these presents do
 give grant & convey unto the said a Negro Man
 of Copper Color named Andrew about twenty two
 years of age. Also A Negro Woman of dark Color
 named Tennessee Eighteen years old and her increase
 I have and hold the said Negro Slaves John
 nevertheless the said Edm^d. King is to keep possession
 of the said Negroes during the present year at a hire
 of one hundred & sixty \$ per dollars & treat them
 in all respects as his own without any charge
 to the said Franklin. In witness whereof I
 hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th day of
 April A.D. 1860
