

The State of Alabama, This deed of conveyance made and ex-
 ecuted this 6th day of Aug. 1863 between
 John Haskins and Sarah Haskins husband & wife of the 1st part
 and J. N. McBlair of the 2nd part, witnesses that the party
 of the first part for & in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand
 and dollars to them in hand paid by the 2nd party the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have given, granted,
 bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant,
 bargain & sell to said 2nd party the following land lying
 and being in County & known as follows, to wit, The
 north half of Section twenty five (25) except 4 acres conveyed
 by D. Green in his life time on the 6th day of July 1841
 to Mr. H. Pope which deed is recorded in the Probate Court
 of said county deed book, The Pages 289 & 290 and 12 acres
 conveyed by deed by D. Green & wife on the 31st day of Jan'y
 1843 to said Mr. H. Pope which is recorded in deed book
 9 at Pages 66 & 67 & 4 acres conveyed by D. Green and
 wife to the Trustees of the male Academy of Columbia
 on the 20th day of April 1857 which is recorded in

deed book 9 at- Pages 420 & 421 & also the north half of the south west quarter of said Section 25 and also the S W 1/4 of the S W 1/4 of Section 24 twenty four and also three acres more or less described as follows, to wit- Commencing at the section line at the carriage house in front of the tavern thence N with the south side of the street leading from said tavern to the barn house to the E boundary of the original town of Columbiana thence south said boundary line to the centre line of said Section 26 thence E with said centre line to the E boundary line of said Section 26 thence to the beginning all in Township 21 Range 1 west to have and to hold to said McClure his heirs & assigns forever, and said 1st party hereby consent and agree with said 2nd party that- They are lawfully seized in fee of said land and premises, and that they will warrant and defend titles in fee simple to said McClure his heirs and assigns forever, Witness our hands & seals the day and year afore said.
