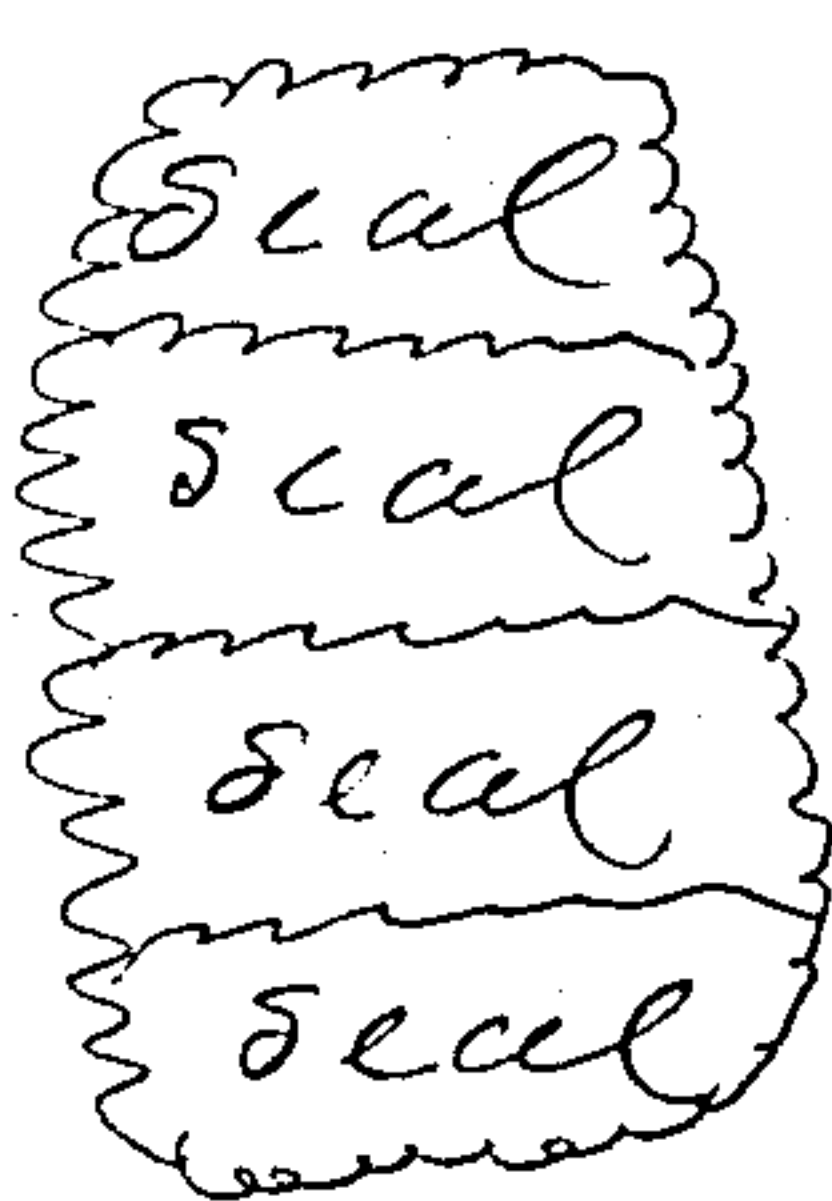


The State of Alabama } This Indenture made and

 in consideration of the sum of six hundred
 dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 to wit Tract No. 5, G. H. J. K & L Section 24 Township
 22 Range 1 West To have and to hold to said 2^d
 party his heirs and assigns forever & we the said
 first party Covenant and agree with said 2^d party
 that we will forever warrant and defend titles
 to said land to said 2^d party - Witness our
 hands & seals
