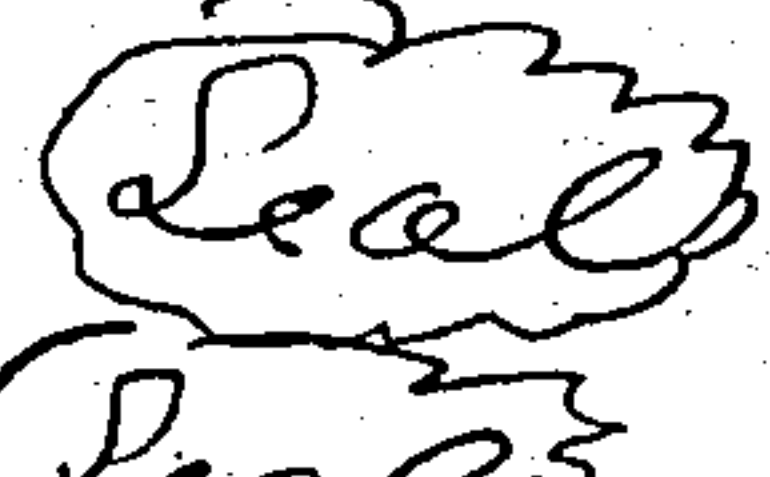
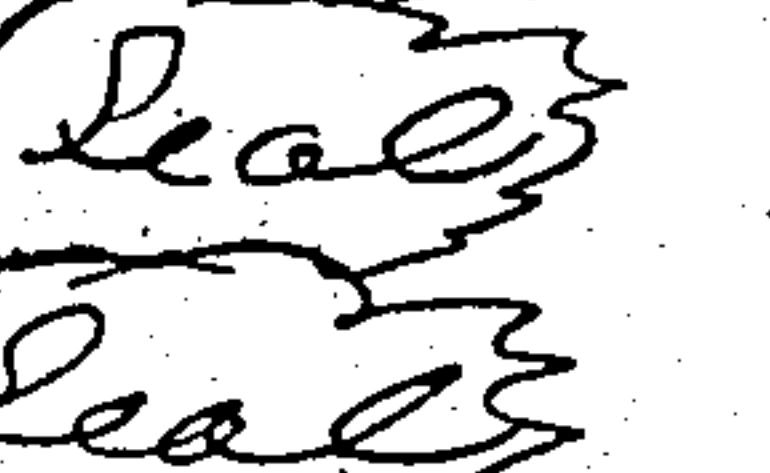
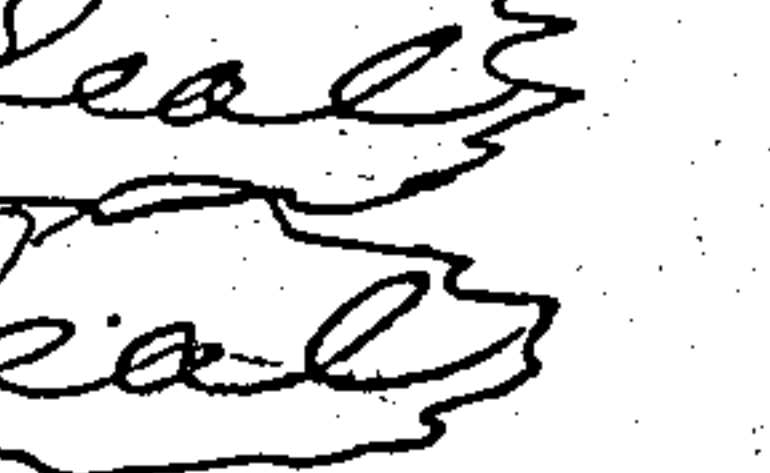
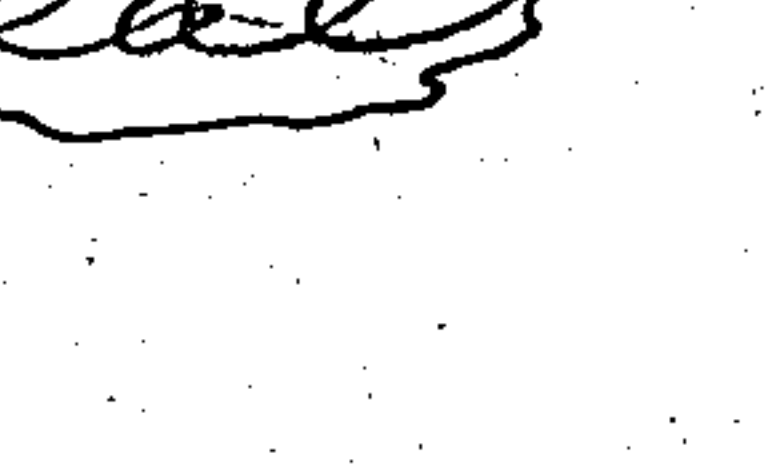


The State of Alabama, This Indenture made and

 to them in hand paid the receipt of which is
 hereby acknowledged in money & promissory notes
 to wit Cash one hundred and fifty dollars Cash
 one hundred dollars to be due 25 Dec next,
 two hundred dollars and fifty dollars to be due
 25 Dec 1863 & Two hundred dollars to be due
 25 Dec 1864, have given, granted, bargained &
 sold, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain
 and sell to said 2nd party the following described
 land, viz: The S W 1/4 of N W 1/4 of Sec 10 S E 1/4
 of N E 1/4 N 1/2 of N E 1/4 & S E 1/4 of N W 1/4
 of Sec 9 T 21 R 1 N to have and hold to said
 Clement Davis his heirs & assigns forever & we cov-
 =enant with said Davis that we will forever warrant
 and defend title to said land, Witness our hands
 & seals,
