 Shelby County 3 and entered into this
 the 17th day of April A.D. 1863 Between John
 Pope of the first part and B. Boyd of the second
 part both of the County and State aforesaid Metropolis
 that the said party of the first part hath this day
 bargained and sold and do by these presents
 bargain and sell unto the party of the second
 part a certain tract or parcel of land lying being
 in the County of Jefferson State of Alabama and in
 the Tuscaloosa land District and known as follows
 (to wit) the North West fourth of the North West quarter
 Section Seven Township 20 Range Third West for
 the Consideration of the sum of two hundred
 dollars in hand paid to the party of the first
 part by the party of the second part the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said
 party of the first part doth for herself her heirs
 Executors Administrators and assigns willARRANT
 and for ever defend all the right title and interest
 of the said land unto the party of the second part
 his heirs &c together with all the improvements and
 appurtenances therunto belonging to have and to
 hold for his own use and benefit In testimony
 whereof I the party of the 1st part have here-
 unto set my name and affixed my seal
 day and year 1st above written.
