 Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa Alabama
 it appears that full payment has been made by
 the said William P Barrow according to the provisions
 of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an
 Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public
 Land for the North West quarter of the South West
 quarter of section numbered in Township twenty-two of
 Range three West in the District of Land subject to
 sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing thirty nine
 acres and eighty two hundredths of an acre according
 to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land return-
 ed to the General Land Office by the Surveyor Gen-
 eral which said Tract has been purchased by the said
 William P Barrow Now Know Ye That the United
 States of America in Consideration of the Promises and
 in Conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such
 Cases made and provided Have given and Grant-
 ed and by these presents Do Give and Grant unto
 the said William P Barrow and to his heirs the said
 Tract above described To Have And To Hold the
 same together with all the rights privileges immu-
 nities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto
 belonging unto the said William P Barrow and to his
 heirs and assigns forever In Testimony Whereof
 I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of
 America have caused these letters to be made
 Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to
 be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at
 the City of Washington the seventh day of July in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
 dred and fifty four and of the Independence
 of the United States the seventy seventh
